One of the main attractions of Kingfisher Court is undoubtedly the fact that it falls within the South Gloucestershire Education Authority and the catchment area of the popular Marlwood School in Alveston. It is also just a couple of minutes walk away from an ofsted commended primary school and nursery. although for a proceedable buyer able to complete in June this last plot can be purchased at a special price of just £250,000. However Martin Newman warns that anyone interested in buying it needs to get in touch as soon as possible before it is snapped up.

One of the properties on Phase 2 has already been reserved so selling agents Connells are expecting it to be just as popular as the first phase and anticipate high levels of demand.
